- Applicants must be a NM high school senior or a NM high school graduate who has been awarded their diploma within the past 12 months or a current student enrolled in a New Mexico college or university.
- Applicants must have a medical diagnosis of Autism Spectrum Disorder.
- Applicants must be pursuing a degree or certificate in a qualified program of training designed to prepare students for gainful employment in a recognized occupation.
- Applicants must be able to provide an acceptance letter or written verification of eligibility to attend from a college or university that is accredited by a nationally recognized accreditation agency.

Application Process

Applicants must meet all qualifying requirements and submit a completed scholarship application with **ALL** required documents attached in order to be considered.

Selection Process

All scholarship applications will be reviewed by the New Mexico Autism Society Scholarship Committee, with applicants being selected based upon their qualifying criteria, completed scholarship application with required documentation, letters of recommendation and essays.
